Pediatric Oncology Massage, Level 1

Learn to provide safe and comforting massage therapy to children with cancer.

This training will help facilitate more accurate patient assessments and supportive massage methods. Family dynamics, childhood physical and emotional development, and strategies for supporting the whole family will be explored.

Protocols and techniques that offer playful and comforting bodywork will be demonstrated. Class participants will have the opportunity to practice these new techniques on each other, and in a clinical simulation setting. Client clinic will be held on the last day of class.

The focus will be on what we can do, and be, with our presence that can make our work infinitely more valuable and connected as we serve the dying.

This class is a combination of scientific and factual information about the physiology and often medical process of dying. Interpersonal exercises to cultivate listening and presence, and self-exploration to better understand our own relationship to mortality are included in this program.

Manual Lymph Drainage (MLD) is a therapeutic form of soft tissue mobilization that significantly enhances lymph formation and promotes drainage within the superficial and deep system of the lymph vascular network. This six-day course will teach you to skillfully apply MD techniques. Participants will be able to:

- Differentiate between the normal and diseased states of the lymphatic system
- Competently perform the techniques of MLD for all body areas
- Develop treatment strategies for indications such as post-surgical edema, post-traumatic edema, fibromyalgia, general detoxification and other conditions
- Competently perform MLD on clients after breast surgery for cancer
- Competently perform MLD on clients with mild, medically uncomplicated, primary or secondary lymphedema
